In 1904 the Catholic Church celebrated the 50th anniversary of the dogma of the Immaculate Conception which Pope Pius IX had proclaimed in 1854. Catholic leaders in Lebanon decided to mark the occasion by erecting a bronze statue of Mary Immaculate on the Rock of Harissa overlooking the city of Jounieh near the Mediterranean Sea. The monumental statue made in France was named Our Lady of Lebanon. It was officially inaugurated on 3 May 1908 and has been celebrated as Our Lady of Lebanon's feast day ever since. Over the years the crowds of believers grew and eventually the church was not large enough to accommodate them so it was decided to build a bigger church. On 31 May 1970 the foundation stone for the new basilica was laid by His Beatitude Maronite Patriarch Paul-Pierre Meouchy in the presence of the then President of Lebanon, Charles Helou, and the Prime Minister Rachid Karame and other dignitaries.
