The "Russell" Collection of Antique Pocket Watches and Vintage Wristwatches

The following collection of antique and vintage pocket watches and wristwatches, known as the "Russell Collection", has been formed by a gentleman over the last forty years.

From the age of 10, the owner was to fall in love with watches and their mechanical intricacies, precipitated by his father leaving the gift of a pocket watch on his window sill one night. The young boy awakening in the morning was mesmerised by the splendour of it. A lifetime of interest blossomed and saw the formation, over his lifetime, of the following 166 lots of gents and ladies, pocket watches, wristwatches, and early instruments spanning some 350 years.

Each watch in the Russell Collection was carefully selected, perhaps for the marque, perhaps for the movement, then serviced and finished to the highest standard by a master tradesman. There are many with complicated movements such as chronometers and chronographs, early water resistant models with patents from Rolex, Omega and others. Some of the famous brands represented are Waltham, Elgin, Bulova, Doxa, Waterbury, Howard, Hamilton, Rotherham, Benson, Seiko, Omega, Rolex, Jaeger Le Coultre, Movado, Hebdomas, Longines and Fortis, just to mention some of the important makers, and of course the prized piece in the Russell Collection, the rare William Dent pair-cased pocket watch from the late 1600's.

Although all the watches in the "Russell Collection" and the "Other Properties" section have all been serviced and presented to the highest possible standard, all are being sold as is. The majority are in working order except where noted. Being time pieces of some age none can be guaranteed to be working or reliable time keepers. We have however described all the pieces as accurately as possible with any major defects noted.
