Catholic leaders in Lebanon decided to mark the occasion by erecting a bronze statue of M ary Immaculate on the Rock of H arissa overlooking the city of Jounieh near the $M$ editerranean Sea. The monumental statue made in France was named Our Lady of Lebanon. It was officially inaugurated on 3 M ay 1908 and has been celebrated as Our Lady of Lebanon's feast day ever since. O ver the years the crowds of believers grew and eventually the church was not large enough to accommodate them so it was decided to build a bigger church.
