Thomas James Lempriere (1796-1852) emigrated to Van Diemen's Land in 1822 and was married in M ay 1823. H ereceived a grant of land and became a merchant and a shareholder of the Bank of Van Diemen's Land. Heformed a company and merchant business in Hobart Town trading as Lempriere \& Co. which failed in 1827, but he had left the company the previous year. He was an artist and diarist whose observations were recorded including a publication on the Penal Settlements of Van Diemen's Land, (see Australian Dictionary of Biography p106 for more detailed biography).

The Tasmanian Bank was formed by J.T.Gellibrand, the former AttorneyGeneral of Tasmania, and his son, and opened in Hobart Town between 31 July and 4 August 1826.

The bank at first issued notes ('Post Bills') of the Spanish dollar series, but following the passing of the 'Sterling M oney Act of 1826' on 22 September, it replaced its notes with Sterling notes at once, but forgeries circulated almost immediately.
$N$ ot long after its establishment, the bank's affairs became heavily oriented in favour of directors and their friends, creating a business monopoly in H obart Town. This resulted in the second dividend paid being $42 \%$ per annum.
The bank however, did not do any extensive business, and closed in early 1829 when Gellibrand transferred his interests to whaling.

The Commercial Bank took over the premises of the Tasmanian Bank in H obart, opening on 29 June 1829.

James Kelly (1791-1859), sealer, pilot and harbourmaster, was born on 24 December 1791 in Parramatta. He travelled extensively including circumnavigating Van Diemen's Land, and discovering Port Davey and M acquarie H arbour. Kelly was appointed pilot and harbourmaster at the Derwent and later as pilot he was engaged in whaling and with additional land ownership he became an important citizen in H obart.

Kelly suffered personal and shipping losses in the 1830 s and by the 1840 s with the depression his losses were heavy forcing him to assign his property to creditors and later accept employment from the port authorities again. He died in H obart on 20 April 1859.
Bank of Van Diemen's Land founded in Hobart in 1823 it closed on 4 August 1891.
