Note from the collector. "It is a miracle that this note survives today given its date of 1 April 1928. One hundred pounds would have been worth a fortune at the time of printing and even more during the subsequent Depression in 1930. In 1928 New Zealand's population was only about 1.4 million. The note was found by a second-hand dealer who had purchased furniture from a deceased estate in the 1960s. The dealer put his hand down between the cushions searching for loose coins when he found an envelope containing this spectacular note which would have been lost to history but for the astute furniture dealer."
