The emperor Jahangir struck a remarkable series of figural type rupees and mohurs, unprecedented for a Muslim prince. Besides extremely rare portrait pieces, he instituted a series of Zodiacal types, each one to be struck in the corresponding month. The obverse dies were reused from year to year, new dated reverses being produced for each subsequent issue. Whereas mohurs were issued for every month, only five types of Zodiacal rupees were issued at Agra mint, a selected few similar types were struck at Ahmadabad, Fathpur and Kashmir mints all are rare. In addition, special specimen strikes were apparently produced for important visitors to the Mogul court, each receiving a coin with his Zodiac symbol.

Born in Rosiers-d gletons, Gregory XI was the last of the French Popes. He achieved his goal of restoring his papal seat in Rome and formally condemned the nineteen propositions of John Wycliffe along with the thirteen articles of the Sacherspiegel. Upon his death, a Roman mob pressured the College of Cardinals to elect an Italian Pope, which they did in Urban VI, only to find themselves at odds with him and to return to Avignon to elect a new French Pope (Antipope Clement VII), ultimately leading to the Western Schism.

The altar boy and nephew of Pope Sixtus IV, Julius II dealt with foreign affairs very forcefully, regaining Perugia and Bologna from their despots, even leading troops himself. In mourning for the loss of Bologna, he wore a beard for nine months, a practice which Clement VII copied and made vogue. Julius II was also a patron of the arts, financing artists such as Michelangelo, Raphael, and Bramante.
