# HUNTER COLLECTION

The vendors of this collection are the children of a prominent Hunter region collector who, as a boy, was impressed by the newly minted 1951 Jubilee and 1954 Royal Visit florins. The beginnings of a halfpenny and penny collection were then formed and gradually many of the gaps were filled.

When his mother saw how serious he was she gave him two half sovereigns and a 1937 crown which were given to her, as a girl, by her grandfather. An uncle also chipped in and gave him a large copper coin which had been taken from a shipwreck. It was many years later that he identified this to be a 1797 cartwheel penny. That coin became the basis of his Proclamation Set which he built upon over the next sixty-five years.

This collection now includes pre-decimal and paper decimal banknotes, a complete halfpenny, penny, threepence, sixpence, shilling, florin and crown sets, a large collection of Australian sovereigns and half sovereigns, a 1981 twenty cent mule, a 2000 one dollar mule, a complete Proclamation set, a complete New Zealand pre-decimal coin set, an English type set, a quality set of Japanese Invasion Money and a small collection of quality ancient coins, all of which are offered in this catalogue.
