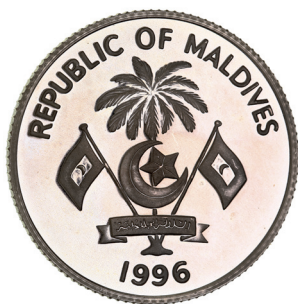

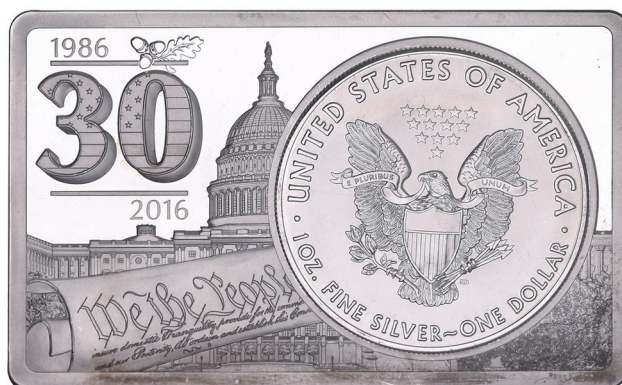

The bridge then opened for use on 23 April 1994. The following medal is attributed to John McLean ASC (Australian Cinematographers Society) who was cameraman for the Australian contingent that built the bridge.
