Bank of Auckland

The Bank of Auckland opened in 1864 and traded for three years until it closed in 1867. Notes were ordered from London but the first issue was a temporary one, printed locally and used until the professionally printed bank notes arrived.



The Bank of Australasia

The Bank of Australasia issued notes in Australia from 1835 and changed the design of their Australian notes in 1863. Plans were made to open branches in New Zealand and proof specimens were ordered dated 1863. The branches opened in 1864 and even though distinctive New Zealand notes had been ordered they didn't arrive in time. Some of the Australian notes were brought over and ultimately used up. Notes were issued by the bank until 1934. In 1951 the bank amalgamated with the Union Bank to form the ANZ Banking Group.

Bank of New Zealand

The Bank of New Zealand was formed in 1861 and was always the most prolific issuer of notes until 1934, probably making up fifty percent of the private trading bank notes still in existence. Before the printed banknotes arrived gold was discovered in Otago and a branch was opened and gold bought with locally printed notes. No notes from that time are extant.







The Commercial Bank of Australia Limited began trading in Melbourne in 1886 and opened branches in New Zealand in 1912. 

The Commercial Bank of New Zealand Limited

The Commercial Bank of New Zealand Limited was formed in London with the name New Zealand Banking Corporation in 1863. Parliament issued a charter to issue banknotes in December 1864 under the new name, presumably after that date. Losses overseas led to the bank closing its doors in 1866 and paying out fifteen shillings in the pound to note holders.



The National Bank of New Zealand Limited

The National Bank of New Zealand Limited was incorporated in London in 1872. The bank began issuing notes from 5th September 1873 and continued until 1934. The designs used were very plain and conservative, in line with their policies, which perhaps explains why this bank is the only bank remaining in Australasia with exactly the same name that it started with. It could be said their designs reamained the same for every type of issue. Their notes accounted for around ten percent of the total issue.

Read. The notes, printed on pink paper were less ornate than their Otago contemporaries. Captain Read was a pioneer settler in the area, and is generally given credit for the foundation of the town of Gisborne, where he arrived in 1852. Read has been described by one East Coast historian as the area's most colourful, most enterprising, and most prosperous pioneer and was regarded as the the uncrowned king of Poverty Bay'. According to Sutherland, Read issued his notes as an advance to pay troops engaged in the Maori Wars, although they are said to have circulated amongst local Maoris as well. It has been recounted that the latter, after quarelling with Read, would enter his store, take some of the Read notes from their pockets and tear them up in order to express their contempt for him. Read, it is said, would pretend to get into a violent rage, and chase his 'enemy' from the store, while silently rejoicing in the profit he had made. Admittedly such an event may have occured once or twice, but it is suggesting a widespread naivety amongst the Maoris concerning paper money which, in fact, did not exist. The Read notes, unlike those issued in the south, were payable to bearer 'on demand'. Just how this was possible under the existing legal restrictions remains to be explained as all the known copies of the notes are unsigned and unissued. It is possible that the notes were, like the Otago Banking Company notes, never in fact issued.' Hargreaves illustrates a note with the number 2833 in the Hocken library for a value of one pound.

RESERVE BANK OF NEW ZEALAND ISSUES

Trading banks had issued their own notes until 1934 when the Reserve Bank of New Zealand was formed as a central bank. One of their functions was to issue banknotes. All trading bank notes ceased to be legal tender on 10th January 1935 but were able to be redeemed by the Reserve Bank at face value until 1st August 1976, at which time £344,939 had not been returned. The first issue, regarded as temporary (because the imminent opening of the bank prevented full consideration of possible designs) was in circulation from 1st August 1934 until 1940, when it was replaced by the so-called permanent issue.

The second issue continued through until the decimal currency change on 10 July 1967, this was followed by the third, fourth and fifth issues.

A sixth series of polymer issues commenced in 1999.

Less than 10 notes known to exist of this rare prefix variety. Alistair Robb states that the prefix was issued in error and that the correct prefix should have been K/0 (letter over number). He estimates that approximately 300,000 were printed around 1955. Robb also notes that the prefix run is 'the end of a sub type and as well as the mintage figure, it has created the rarest Reserve Bank note. In 1998 only 7 notes were known'.
